The Backup Withholding pages were updated to reflect the new rate of 24%. Various links were updated on the Form 990 topic. For 1098 and 1099 pages there was a modification to Mortgage Debt Relief section noting the PMI/mortgage debt forgiveness tax was extended through 2017.

• June 2018 - Employment Channel Topic - Employee Retirement Income Security Act (ERISA) This topic was expanded to include information on the recent regulatory changes effective April 2018.

FTC mails checks to victims of fake debt collection scheme

The Federal Trade Commission reports that it is mailing 597 checks totaling more than \$184,000 to people who were allegedly tricked into paying phony debts. In October 2015, the FTC and the State of New York charged a group of defendants known as Delaware Solutions with collecting on debts that they knew were bogus. According to the complaint, the defendants ignored evidence that the debts were invalid, failed to identify themselves as debt collectors, falsely portrayed themselves as process servers or attorneys, and falsely threatened arrest or litigation for failure to pay. The defendants agreed to – and in August 2016, a federal court in New York entered – an order that permanently banned them from the debt collection industry. The average refund amount is \$308.37.

Bank loses \$2.4M in two attacks

A U.S. bank has been the victim of two cyber attacks in under a year that resulted in \$2.4 million in total losses. A phishing email targeting a bank employee gave hackers access to an internal workstation in May of 2016,

Costly insider threats

In the past two years, the average number of insider-related incidents involving employee or contractor negligence has increased from 10.5 to 13.4, and the number of credential theft incidents has tripled, according to the Ponemon Institute <u>2018 Cost of Insider Threats</u> report. What comes as no surprise is the research firm's findings that the financial services industry takes the hardest hit from insider threats, with total annualized losses of \$12.05 million. <u>Security Week magazine shares more information here.</u>.
